REQUEST FOR OFFICIALS CLINICS FOR 2017-2018

Looking a bit further ahead we are asking clubs/regions to identify the needs for officials' development clinics for next year. Level 1 Intro Clinics can generally be organized on relatively short notice. Higher level clinics require more lead time as course conductors are assigned competitions in an already busy season. Please provide us with a list of needs by Feb 27, 2017

ACCREDITATION NEW OFFICIALS AND OFFICIALS UPGRADING 2016-2017

At season's end ODC will be compiling a list of names of officials for (1) <u>Level 1 accreditation</u>, and (2) <u>Upgrading to Level 2</u>. This is the prerogative of BCSSA ODC. We are also looking at recommending Level 2 Officials to SSC ODC for <u>upgrading to Level 3</u>. SSC ODC will then review that list and decide.

If you are interested in being accredited or upgraded, it is important to follow the guidelines and submit your request with documentation to BCSSA ODC by March 19, 2017
