Growth & Marketing

Time and resources have continued to slow our First Nations and In-Line initiatives. That said we have clubs that are currently working with first Nations and have an In-line component within their club training.

We are very pleased to be entering into our 3rd year of the BC Speed Skating Academy. While year 1 was a success, year 2 with 4 distinct locations saw our registration triple.

All BCSSA Academy locations provide similar programing opportunities to all Academy athletes supporting and enhancing the coach programming they get at their home clubs. This initiative brings our club skaters together with third party on-ice coaching along with off ice programs working to develop truly well rounded athletes...

In May we are launching our Racing to Red Deer program which is the official start of our 2019 Canada Winter Games Preparation. This along with our Speed Skating Academy program helps provide a road map for our skaters working towards their goals of excellence.

Membership

Overall membership numbers showed a slight decrease of about 2% for 2016/17 season. However we look forward to taking advantage of the upcoming Olympic Games to help create more awareness of Speed Skating throughout our communities and grow our membership.
